We are so pleased how our summer 2020 camps went! Over 1000 campers and over 40 staff went through our camps with extremely strict COVID-19 Procedures and all were COVID FREE! We were able to get all our kids to enjoy the outdoors and socialize and learn some skills a long the way.

No Refunds even if it is due to COVID concerns but you can receive a credit on all camps up to June 20th. If there is COVID Health issue you will receive a credit to be used on any of our camps up to 5 years. It is also transferable.

Our top priority is the health and safety of our campers, parents, and staff. After much counsel and speaking with public health officials, we have decided at this time, that it would be too risky and unsafe to use busing services to and from Camp Fortune.

For this summer, parents/guardians will need to organize carpooling and/or drive their children to and from Camp Fortune. We will no longer have this service.

New for this summer, all NKC camps at Camp Fortune will run out of the larger, newer, main chalet. All camps will continue to run from 9 AM to 4 PM daily with the addition of pre-and post care from 8-9 AM and 4-5:00 PM.

We will be sending everyone all our COVID-19 procedures. As

well as we are getting a new website with a COVID-19 Portal for all parents.

Skills taught/practiced include shelter and fire building, wilderness medicine, teamwork, traps, orienteering, fishing and food preparation, and primitive pottery.
